



IN LOVING MEMORY OF OUR FORMER MISSIONARY



PAUL TAN CHEE SIM

In 1 Peter 3:15, the apostle exhorts the believer to always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. He adds that you should do this with gentleness and respect. The late Paul Tan, one of Bartley Christian Church's pioneer missionary's, embodies this gentleness and respect in every sphere of his life. Never shying away from difficult conversations about God or the Bible, patient with young believers and curious unbelievers alike. He was one you could count on to always have an answer for the eternal hope we know he now rests in.

Fifteen years Paul spent toiling on the field, a place we cannot name in the South of Thailand. Learning the language, observing the local people and subsequently becoming a part of their community. Most significant are his contributions to the work of Bible translation. First the work of translating the Bible into a local dialect, widely used in that region. Then, more notably, the Thai Common Language Bible, which meant that now the everyday Thai could read the Bible in an accessible manner.

But Paul did not go alone - he fondly refers to Moh Leng, his wife, as his pillar of strong emotional support. His children, Joanne and Joshua, as precious gifts from the Lord. This beautiful family of four, lived missionally in a time where cross-cultural missionaries from Singapore were few and far between.

Even after his retirement, he continued to serve his God diligently. Leading his Missional Cell, ministering to us through the choir, evangelising to those outside the church. All this he did, over and above grandfather duties, which he thoroughly enjoyed.

A fellow Bible translator and beloved brother read these words to Paul, as a few of us had the privilege of partaking in communion with him on 30th December 2024. We'd like to end with these words as a tribute to a life well-lived and a journey of faith fought well to the end

'For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time for my departure is near. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day —and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.' (2 Timothy 4:6-8)


